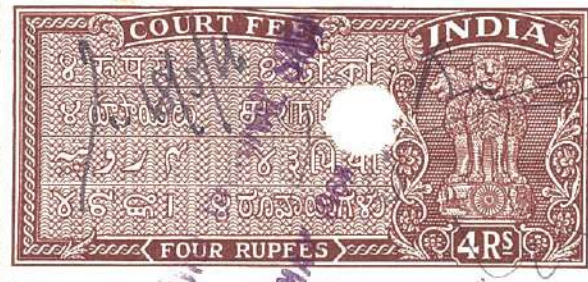

Instrument of Will

This instrument of last will is to be effect following: -

It is executed by Shri Ramesh Chandra Chattopadhyay - son of late Sri Kuntla Chandra Chattopadhyay (Brahmin, occupation service, of No. 9/11 Fern Road, Ballygunge (within the area of) Sub-Registry Office, Thana Ballygunge, District 24 Parganas. I have grown old, now I am running 70 years. Immediately after the death of my wife my old ailment - rheumatism has aggravated; I have not come round in spite of spending lot of money and ~~and~~ undergoing various treatments. There is no certainty as to when I would die. In these circumstances having considered it necessary to have arrangements and settlements made with regard to all my properties, I make the following will with regard to my moveable and immovable properties.

Wives are at present - my three sons Shri Purna Madhale Chattopadhyay, Shri Bhupati Kanti Chattopadhyay and Shri Patil Palani Chattopadhyay, three daughters Shri mati Sailabala Debi, Srimati Kila Debi and Shri mati Chhaya Debi, and the widow of my eldest son Beni Madhale Chattopadhyay deceased - Shri mati Asha Debi and the only daughter of the said Beni Madhale Shri mati Putul Debi. These given my said three daughters Shri mati Sailabala Debi, Shri mati Kila Debi and Shri mati Chhaya Debi and the daughter of my eldest son Beni Madhale deceased the said Putul Debi proper education and have married them spending lot of money to suitable and good bride grooms and all of them along with their children, are living with their husbands in happiness and affluent circumstances. Since after the death -

of my eldest son I have been looking after supporting and maintaining his widow Shri mati Asha Debi and the said Asha Debi has been entrusted with Puja and worship of the deity. I saw Shri Shri Ratha Gossain in my residential house situated at the premises No. 9/11, Fern Road. Shri mati Asha Debi has also been duly nursing and taking care of me in this old age of mine. I consider it proper to have provisions for support and maintenance made with regard to the said Asha Debi. With myself earned income, in 1948 I constructed a three storied house (brick-built) residential house at Holding No. 9/11 Fern Road, of the Corporation of Calcutta and have been residing there along with my family including my son Shri man Bhupati Kanti

Chattopadhyay shall get my said house situate at no 9/11, Fern Road and being appointed (as) the owner vested with rights to the extent of sixteen annas in respect of the said house he shall enjoy and possess the same down to his sons, sons sons and heirs in succession. The widow of my eldest son Shrimati Asha Debi remains entrusted with the puja and worship of the deity Swar Shri Shri Radha Golinda installed in the said house. Throughout her life it is she who shall perform the puja and worship of the deity Swar. Shri Shri Radha Golinda and for the said puja a sum of 10/- ten rupees at least shall be spent per month out of the income from my properties. Until my said house be sold or alienated my said widow Asha Debi shall be entitled, in accordance with her wishes to live in the residential room adjacent to the thakur ghar on the north of the said house with all kinds of easement rights, so that nobody shall be entitled to raise any objection or plea. For the maintenance of the said Asha Debi a sum of 40/- forty rupees at least shall be spent per month out of the income from my properties. The executor appointed by me either by will or out of my portion of the said house.

and from the net ^{income} - that is to say out of the income from my other properties shall meet the said expenses for the puja of the deity and the said expenses for the maintenance of Shrimati Asha Debi. If my third son Bhupati Nath sells the said house, he shall out of the sale proceeds, make permanent arrangements for the puja and worship of the deity Shri Shri Radha Golind and good arrangements for my eldest daughter - in law Shrimati Asha Debi so that she may lead a respectable life duly. If Shri man Bhupati Nath out of the said sale proceeds, do not make good arrangements for Asha Debi to enable her to lead a respectable life, then Shrimati Asha Debi shall with the help of law obtain a decree from the Court for the money required for her reasonable maintenance. If there be any balance left of the said sale proceeds after the aforesaid two instructions have been carried out, then Shri man Bhupati Nath shall be competent to spend the said money in any way he likes keeping in view the requirements of religion and duty so that no objection by any other son shall be admissible upon my death. The executor appointed by me shall out of the

remaining cash money, belonging to me, spend for my death etc.
such sum as he would deem fit and shall also spend the
sum that would be necessary for taking out probate of this
will and funeral & hence no debt. God forbid, if he is required
by me to incur any debt before my death my executor shall

will remain as balance upon deducting the said expenses
didone etc. and the residue of my other movable and immo-
vable properties if there be any shall be had by my three sons
Shani Madhale, Bhupati Nalli and Patil Paban and my sons
widow Shrimati Asha Debi in equal shares and absolute
right with rights to make gifts etc.

upon my death, shall with the money lying deposited
take out the probate of my will without being required to
furnish security and shall carry out the instructions
contained in this will.

To this import, of a true and good faith, without
being requested by any body, being in possession of senses and
having adequately learnt and understood the purport of this
will, I execute this instrument of last will. Given (dated) 1st
Paus of the year 1370 B.S. (corresponding to) 32d January
of the year 1964.

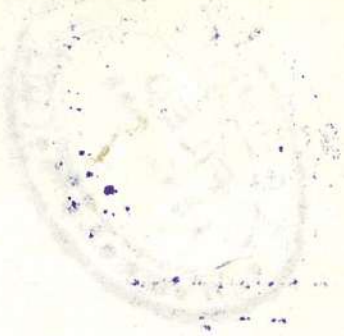
