



hereinafter mentioned, the said Sarba Ranjan Bysack further confirmed and assured such endowment by a duly registered declaration of Trust dated the 20th February, 1959 and registered on the 23rd February, 1959 in Book No. I, Volume No. 38 at pages 106 to 108 being No. 908 for the year 1959 with the Registrar of Assurances, Calcutta.


AND WHEREAS the said Sarba Ranjan Bysack died on the 2nd June 1960 leaving his last WILL AND TESTAMENT dated the 21st February, 1959 whereby and whereof he appointed his only son Sri Biswa Ranjan Bysack as the Sole Shebait of the said Deity and Idol Sri Sri Iswar Balaram Jiu Thakur and allied deities.

AND WHEREAS said Biswa Ranjan Bysack used to act as Sole Shebait and/or Trustee and collected the rents, issues and profits from the following Debuttar properties namely:-

- 1. Premises No. 1A & 1B, Chaitan Sett Street, Calcutta-7, under Police Station Burrabazar.
- 2. Premises No.60, Sir Hari Ram Goenka Street,
  Calcutta-7, under Police Station Burkazak
  Burrabazar.
- Premises No. 16, Brindaban Bysack Street,
   Calcutta-5, under Police Station Jorabagan.
- 4. Premises no.7, Harish Chandra Pal Lane, Cossipore, Calcutta-50, under Police Station Cossipore.

AND WHEREAS the said Biswa Ranjan Bysack also carried out the daily worship, engage regular priests and spend income of the said Debuttar Properties for the angmentation of Sheba Puja and other religion function during his life time.

AND WHEREAS the said Biswa Ranjan Bysack died on the 20th August, 1980 leaving behind a WILL dated loth December, 1970 save and except the present Shebaits Sri Bijal Kumar Basak and Sri Badal Kumar Basak, who are jointly used to hold the Shebaitship of the said Biswa Ranjan Bysack, since deceased.

AND WHEREAS both the present Shebaits are duly and regularly and absolutely managing the Trust Properties of the Deities aforesaid, realising income of the properties, disbursed the same for the Sheba Puja of the Idol and are making management of the said properties in their absolute right and power.

AND WHEREAS it is now necessary and expedient to frame certain rules and regulations and to give certain directions for the daily Sheba Puja of the Idol and management of the Trust Properties for the future guidance of the Shebaits who will be so appointed by virtue of inheritance from the present Shebaits under the Hindu Succession Act, 1956.

AND WHEREAS for the aforesaid reasons and with the object of making proper and adequate provisions for the due performance of management, protection, preservation and upkeep of the said Debuttar Trust Estate and Properties, the following rules are framed for the future management of the Trust Properties and Sheba Puja of the said Idol as aforesaid in the manner hereinafter appearing.

## NOW THIS SCHEME FOR MANAGEMENT WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

l. Shebaits/Trustees shall by and amongst themselves or through their agent/agents employed and appointed by them to manage or deal with the Trust Properties in such manner as might be most beneficial to the interest of the said Deity Trust and Estate and shall realise the rents, issues and profits from the said Trust Properties hereinbefore mentioned including all other incomes acquiring from the Trust Properties and the Shebaits/Trustees shall make formal endorsements and execute necessary documents, grant necessary receipts and/or do several such things as may be legally necessary to enable the Trustees and/or Shebaits to realise

- 2. The Trustees and Shebaits shall not be competent to sell, mortgage, lease or gift otherwise transfer the Trust Properties save and except for the legal necessity as may be decided by the majority decision of Shebaits/Trustees having proper jurisdiction of power, right and this duty, wested upon them by the Scheme of Management.
- 3. During their natural life the present Shebaits and Trustees namely Sri Bijal Kumar Basak and Sri Badal Kumar Basak or the survivor or survivors of them shall be and act as Trustees and/or the Sole Shebaits or Shebait of the said Deity.
- 4. The Shebaits and Trustees shall allow the said
  Deity to remain permanently located at Kailash Dham being
  premises No.7, Harish Chandra Pal Lane, Calcutta-50 or in
  such other place as may be necessary proper and allow the
  Shebaits to carry on daily Sheba Puja or Worship and to
  observe and perform the periodical ceremonies as usual

- 6. To pay regularly and punctually all rents, taxes, salaries and other outgoings in respect of the said Trust Properties and to disburse and distribute from time to time such sums as may be required to make repairs to the Trust Properties being the Debuttar Estate aforesaid to pay all legal charges for the proper execution and discharge of the Trust and to allow the balance to accumulate and invest the accumulated funds in good and marketable securities, post office or Nationalised Banks and to spend the income or interest thereof wholly and exclusively or in part on the occassion and performance of alls or any periodical ceremonies of the said Deities.
- the ornaments, utensils and other articles and things belonging to the said Deities in their own place and/or safe deposit vault if necessary. The Shebaits/Trustees shall be entitled to open a Banking Account in the name of <u>SRI SRI ISWAR BALARAM JEW</u> and shall be entitled to operate the said account opened in the name and style of <u>SRI SRI ISWAR BALARAM JEW</u>. The Shebaits/Trustees shall be entitled to open a vault with a Nationalised Bank. After holding a meeting drawing the proper minutes and serve the valid resolutions to the respective authority concern after completion of the terms of Shebaitsipp.

- 9. To maintain proper books of accounts of the income and expenditures, disbursements made from the funds of the Trust Estate of SRI SRI ISWAR BALARAM JEW THAKUR.
- 10. To demand and sue for and recover all monies payable to or receivable by the Deities, the Trust funds and/or the Shebaits and to give effectual receipts and discharges for the same.
- 11. To execute and defend actions and proceedings which may be brought by or against the Deities and the Trust funds and/or the Shebaits and to sign and affirm, plead, petitions, statements and affidavit and to do all things necessary in connection therewith.
- 12. To sign, execute and register all deeds, pattahs, instruments and writings as may be necessary and deem fit and proper for the benefit and welfare of the Estate of the Deities aforesaid.
- 13. To act generally and prudently and devotedly for the welfare of the Deities aforesaid as well as betterment and development of the said Debuttar Estate namely SRI SRI ISWAR BALARAM JEW THAKUR.

- 14. The Trustees shall act by majority unless they equally devided in their opinion and in which case the opinion of the Senior most among them shall prevail.
- 15. On the death of the present Shebaits their survivor or survivors shall be the Shebaits and Trustees of the Deities and the Trust Estate. The office of the Trustees and Shebaits shall be hereditory and shall devolve upon the lineal discendents of the Shebaits, provided always, if any of such Shebaits renounce the Hindu religion and adhere to any other religion, he shall be disqualified from the Shebaitship and the office of the Trustee as Trusteeship. To hold an annual meeting of the Shebaits and to elect by voting two senior and/or competent and/or responsible Trustees and Shebaits to carry out the functions of the Trust Estate and Sheba Puja of the Thakur and to hold periodical ceremonies. One discendant each from the survivings of the present two Shebaits shall be elected or selected for acting as Shebaits/Trustees, necessary resolution shall be recorded and set out and forwarded to concerning Bank, Post office and other offices.
- 16. The Shebaits so elected and/or selected shall hold office for a term of five years and at the end of such five years two further Shebaits shall be elected by voting or selected by nomination by majority of all the Shebaits as indicated above. Such two trustees shall be the MANAGING SHEBAITS of the Trust Estate. A resolution duly proposed in such....

such annual meeting of the Shebaits appointing and empowering the newly elected trustees of the end of such 5 years shall be forwarded to the relevant banking accounts and locker of the Deities aforesaid.

- 17. The Shebaits and Trustees shall be empowered to invest any accumulated trust funds in immovable properties, if any, as approved and shall provide maintenance for such immovable properties from the Trust funds.
- 18. To appoint clerks, Pujaris, Guards, Servants and other as may be necessary for proper conducting and maintenance of the worship of the Daily and they shall also have power to dismiss all or any of the Pujaris, Servants and Guards, so appointed and may appoint others in their or his place or places and to pay proper monthly other wages to the person so appointed from the Trust Fund.
- 19. The Shebaits and Trustees for the time being shall maintain a Minute Book of the proceedings of every meeting to be held as aforesaid and the same shall sign by the Senior Shebaits and Trustees present in such meeting.
- 20. If any of the Shebaits become entitled to the office of the Shebaits and Trustees during his minority then his natural guardian or any other guardian appointed during his minority shall act on behalf of the minor Trustee as aforesaid.

- 21. In case of difference of opinion amongst the Shebaits/Trustees majority will role but if the declarants are alive their opinion will prevail.
- 22. Both the declarants hereby reserves the right to alter, add, modify and rectify any clause of this Scheme for Management of the Debuttar Estate aforesaid if deemed necessary in future.
- 23. That any of the above terms may be varied, altered, amended and/or added to by the mutual consent of the Shebaits/Trustees hereof to be either expressed in writing or implied from conduct.
- 24. That all differences or disputes in the conduct, management and working and also performance of Daily Seba Puja including periodical festivals as well as retirement and inclusion of new Shebaits/Trustees or their rights and duties of the individual sebait shall forthwith be referred to arbitration accordingly subject to the provisions of the Indian Arbitration Act(Act of 1940) or any other law for the time being in force.
- 25. That all the Shebaits shall work and perform their duties honestly and diligently for the betterment and development and also performance of daily Seba Puja of the Deity SRI SRI ISWAR BALARAM JEW and allied dities and that none of the Shebaits shall become borrow anything

or incur any expenditure for his and/or her personal gains and benefit in individual capacity by acting as a Shebaits/Trustees of the Debuttar Estate of SRI SRI ISWAR BALARAM
JEW.

- 26. None of the Shebaits/Trustees shall assign, mortgage or charge or sell his/her share of the Sheba Puja and in any portion part of Debuttar aforesaid to the third party for any reason what seever.
- 27. That dishonesty, fraud and misconduct by any one Shebaits/Trustees will expel the Shebait from his/her Sebaitship and the misappropriated amount will be recovered from his/her share in the Debuttar Estate aforesaid.
- 28. That the violation of any of the terms mentioned in this Scheme of Management by any one of the Shebaits/
  Trustees will be considered as a BREACH OF TRUST.
- Trustees are now of 80 years and 64 years respectively and are of indifferent health and both the Executants are of and for effectuating of their aforesaid desire and their Shebaitship unto the new four Shebaits/
  Trustees upon trust hereinbefore declared so that there may not arise any dispute and difference as to the same after their death.
- 30. That all the four Executants as to the newly appointed Shebaits/Trustees (i) Sri Pronay Kumar Basak, (ii) Sri Swapan Kumar Basak


