DEMOLITION, WORK IN DEMOLITION

"CONSTRUCTION SITE SHALL BE MAINTAINED TO PREVENT MOSQUITO BREEDING AS REQUIRED U/S 498(1) & (2) OF CMC ACT 1980, IN SUCH MANNER SO THAT ALL WATER COLLECTIONS PARTICULARLY LIFE WELLS, VATS, BASEMENT SURGING SITES OPEN RECEPTACLES ETO AS EMPITED COMPLETELY TWICE & WEAR"

No rain water pipe should be fixed or discharged in road or on path. Drainage plan should be submitted at the time of sanction and the sanction obtained before proceeding with the drainage work

Before starting any construction the site must conform with plans sanctioned and all the conditions as proposed in the plan should be fulfilled. The validity of the written permission to execute the work is subject to the above conditions.

A suitable pump has to be provided i.e. pumping unfiltered water for the distribution to the flushing cisterns and urinals in the building in case unfiltered water from street main is not available.

Plan for Water Supply arrangement including SEMI I.C. & G.I. pipes and the E.C.M. While submitting the sanction charges to be levied for the work of Water Supply any revision may lead to disconnection/demolition.

CONSTRUCTION SITE SHALL BE MAINTAINED FREE FROM LITTER AND DEBRIS TO AVOID MOSQUITO BREEDING AS PER ANNEXURE OF THE AMENDMENT OF 31.07.2015 (IDE NO. 9/M/2015-4) SCHEDULE IV OF M.C. BUILDING RULE 2019

Upon Commencement of Erection/ Re-Erection within Five year will Require Fresh Application for Sanction.

All Building Materials to necessary & construction should conform to the standards specified in the National Building Code of India.

Design of all Structural Members including that of the foundation should conform to Standards specified in the National Building Code of India.
