AND WHEREAS In view of admission and retirement, the books of account of the partnership firm have been finalized, balance sheet has been drawn upto 15.08.2023. That the partners have mutually agreed that capital balance of Mita Dutta Biswas as on this date of Dood will be transferred to Partha Sarathi Dutta Biswas being her spouse and to this the Retiring Party Smt. 1) BUSINESS:

That the business of the partnership firm shall remain to be that of partnership business of Contractor work of Construction and General Order Supply, under the trade name & style of 'DCP ENTERPRISES'.

2) NAME AND ADDRESS OF BUSINESS:

That the partnership business shall henceforth be carried on and continued to be carried on under the same trade name and style of 'DCP ENTERPRISES' but the partners have decided to change the registered address of the firm and the new address will be B-1, Second Floor, Vivekananda Mini Market, Hill Cart Road, Siliguri -734001, P.O. & P.S. SILIGURI Dist. Darjeeling 734001. Parties shall be at liberty to open branch/branches at such place or places and to close the same with mutual agreements between themselves and the retiring party has no objection if the trade name is continued by the continuing parties.

3) COMMENCEMENT AND DURATION:

That the partnership hereby reconstituted have commenced on and from this 15th Day of AUGUST, 2023 and shall continue unless determined by a party to others at the address of the business.


4) CAPITAL OF THE NEW PARTNERSHIP:

5) INTEREST ON CAPITAL:

That the continuing parties shall be entitled to get simple interest @ 12 % on Capital or such other higher or lower rate which may be allowed as deduction under section 40(b)(iv) or under any other provision of the Income Tax Act.

6) WORKING PARTNER AND REMUNERATION:

That First Second & Third Parties to this Reconstituted Deed of Partnership shall be working partners and have agreed to devote their time, energy and attention to the business of partnership and in consideration thereof, they shall be entitled to receive remuneration in their profit/loss sharing ratio subject to the availability of profit which is to be determined in the following manner:-

Note: Book profit means the net profit as defined in Explanation-3 of section 40(b)(iv) of the Income Tax Act,1961.

That the remuneration payable to the working partners shall be computed in the manner laid down in explanation 3 to Sec 40(b) of the Income Tax Act, 1961 or any other applicable provisions as may be in force in the Income Tax assessment of the partnership firm of the relevant accounting year. Such amount shall be distributed among the working partners in their profit/loss sharing ratio. The working partners shall be entitled to withdraw out remuneration for their personal needs from time to time.

7) PROFIT AND LOSS:

That the profit and losses of partnership firm after deducting all expenses relating the partnership business as well interest on capital and remuneration, if payable to the continuing parties in accordance with the preceding clauses No. 5 & 6 of this Deed of Partnership, shall be divided between and borne by the parties in the following shares:-

First Party	-----	1/3 Shares in Profit / Loss
Second Party	-----	1/3 Shares in Profit / Loss
Third Party	-----	1/3 Shares in Profit / Loss

8) ACCOUNTS:

(A) That the books of accounts together with all other papers and documents shall be kept at the place of business of the firm and all parties at all reasonable times, be entitled to inspect or take copies or the extract thereon.

(B) That the Accounts of the firm shall be adjusted annually on 31st Day of March of every year or any other interval period when the profit or loss as the case may be shall be ascertained and divided amongst the parties according to their share mentioned else where in this Deed.

9) BANK ACCOUNTS:

That the existing bank accounts already opened or any other bank account or accounts to be opened with any Nationalized /Commercial Bank or any other Banks as may be decided by the continuing parties shall be operated by signature of anyone of the PARTIES of the FIRST & SECOND PARTS of this Deed executed on 15th Day of August, 2023.

10) LOANS AND ADVANCES:

That for the benefits and interest of partnership business any advance or loan may be taken from any person or financial institution or Government Body or Bank on payment of interest on the said advance or loan as may be agreed between the parties and the said continuing parties shall be jointly liable for the payments of such advance or loan including interest payable thereon in the ratio as mentioned in the Clause No. (7) here in above.

11) RIGHT CLAUSE / FORBIDDEN CLAUSE:

- a) Each and every continuing party shall be entitled to represent the firm and sign all vouchers, contracts, invoices, mercantile and other papers, affidavits for and on behalf of the firm.
- b) That each continuing party shall punctually pay and discharge his separate debts and liabilities and shall keep the firm and its partners effectually indemnified against the same.
- c) That the continuing parties shall be just and faithful to each other and shall work for the best interest of the partnership business.
- d) That each continuing party shall at all times give to the other party the true information and faithful explanation of all matters relating to the partnership business.
- e) That for any personal loan or liability of the individual party, the firm shall not be liable for the payment thereof.
- f) That no partner shall act in manner which is detrimental to the interest of the partnership.
- g) That no partner without the consent of the other partner shall:-
 - i) employ any of the money, goods or effect of the partnership or pledge the credit thereof except in the ordinary course of business or for the benefit of the partnership.

ii) enter into any bond or become baillee or surety or sureties with or for any person or do or knowingly cause or suffer to be done anything whereby the partnership properties or any part thereof may be seized, attached, entered or taken into execution.

12) RETIREMENT:

A) The duration of the partnership shall be 'AT WILL' but if any of the continuing partners shall desire to retire from the partnership business, he/she shall give two months' notice to that effect to other partner. Notice may be waived by mutual consent.

B) On retirement of any of the partners, the retiring partner shall be entitled to receive his share of capital and/or contribution in the partnership firm including interest thereon accrued, if any, and profit and loss upto the date his retirement.

C) That the existing partners may for the expansion of the business admit new partner/partners and on admission this Deed of Partnership executed on this date shall be amended accordingly.

13) DEATH AND INSANITY:


That incase of insanity, permanent physical disability or death or any of the partners, the firm shall not stand dissolved but can be continued as a going concern by the remaining partner.

14) DISSOLUTION:

15) ARBITRATION:


16) GENERAL CLAUSE:
