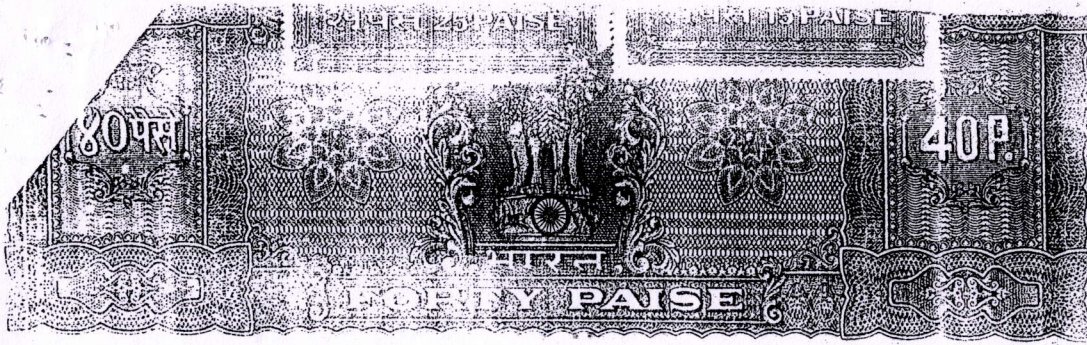

After marriage they lived as husband and wife and a son was born to them who is now aged about 21. The respondent, as is alleged, became indifferent, towards the some years after the marriage and ultimately deserted the petitioner from the first part of October, 1970 without his consent and any reasonable cause from their last residence at 13B Hindusthan Park, P.S. Ballygunge within jurisdiction of the court. Since October, 1973 her present whereabouts, is not known to the petitioner. Petitioner alleges that there is no collusion as to this suit between them. He prays for a decree of divorce on the ground of desertion since October, 1970 and for than three years. Petitioner's case is proved by PW-1, the petitioner himself.

Hence,

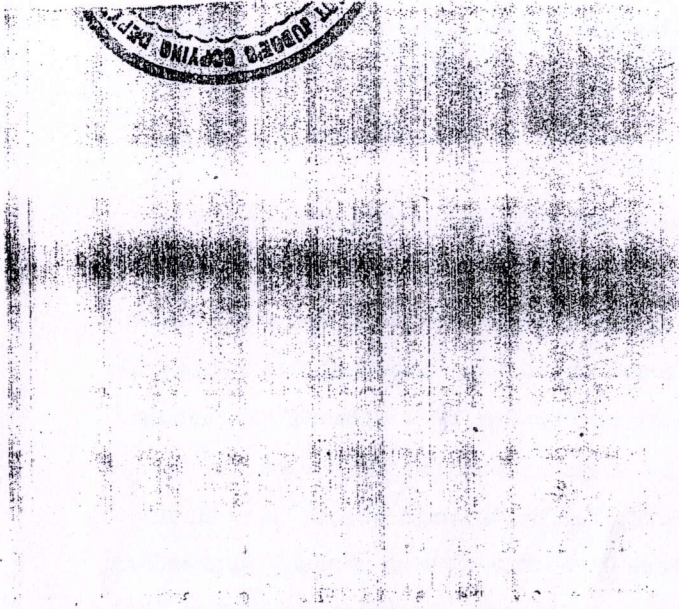
Ordered,
