

part; WHEREAS the said Haridas Dutt, who was a Hindu inhabi-
tant of Calcutta, governed by the Dayabhag or Bengal School
of Hindu Law, was during his life seized and possessed of or
otherwise well and sufficiently entitled to the properties

an Instrument of Gift made on and bearing date the 20th day


