

With reference to above cited subject, permission from Wildlife point of view is hereby given for construction of proposed residential complex on the land mentioned on the subject, which has a road distance around 4.431 Km (approximately) and arial distance 3.023 Km (approximately) from the boundary of the Chintamani Kar Bird Sanctuary at Narendrapur, under 24 Parganas (South) District with the following conditions:

1. Necessary precautions should be taken to prevent any activity detrimental to birds and their free movement in and around the Chinatamani Kar Bird Sanctuary.
2. They should not use unnecessary bright lights that could deter the biological rhythm of the birds.
3. There should not be open garbage dumps around which may attract birds and other animals.
4. Necessary directive should be followed as specified by the MoEF & CC (ESZ Division), Govt. of India published in the Gazette of India, vide No. 3344(E), dtd. 16.10.2017 regarding declaration of Eco-sensitive Zone, around Chintamani Kar Bird Sanctuary at Narendrapur, in the State of West Bengal (copy enclosed)
