CONSTRUCTION SHALL BE MANAGED
TO PROTECT ADJACENT PROPERTIES AS REQUIRED

No rain water pipe should be fixed to
the exterior wall of a building. The
down pipe should be submitted as
part of the building application and
proceeding with the drainage work.

Before starting any construction work
the contractor shall submit a plan
and all the conditions as proposed in the plan
to the Building Department for
approval. The contractor shall
proceed with the work in accordance
with the approved plan.

A suitable pump has to be provided in
the building to pump the rain water
to the street level. The pump should
be installed in a suitable location
and the contractor shall be
responsible for the maintenance
of the pump.

Plan for Water Supply arrangement including
the location of the water supply
and the connection to the street
supply and the section obtained before
the work is started. The contractor
shall be responsible for the
maintenance of the water supply
arrangement.

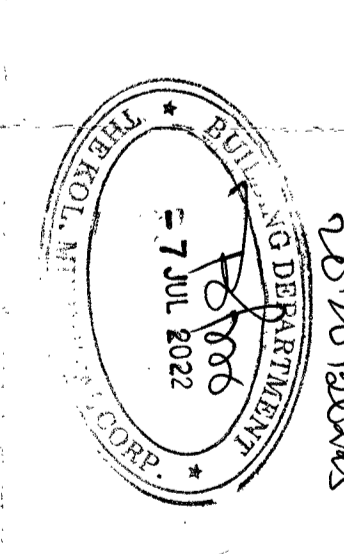
