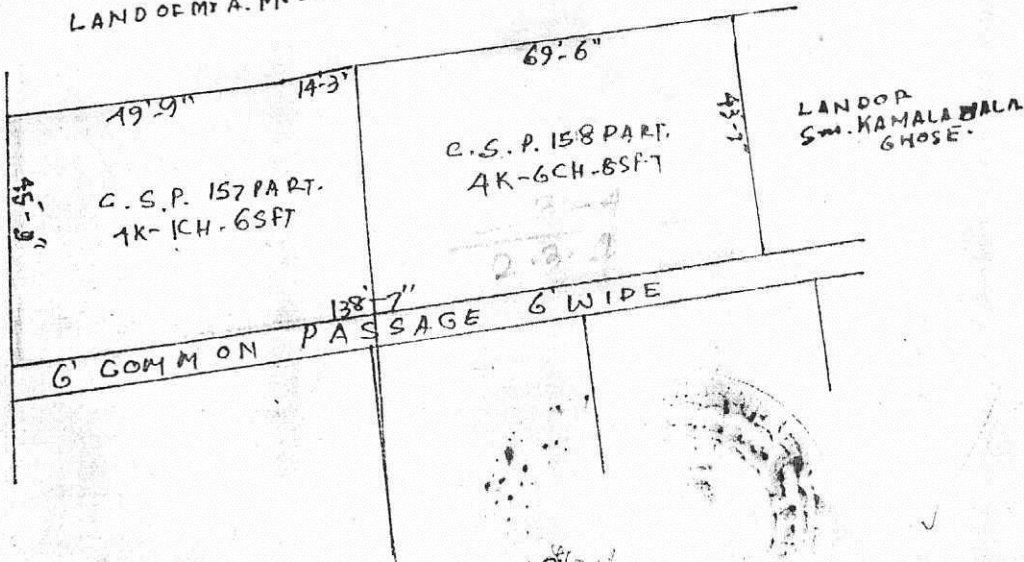
LAND PLAN OF DAG NOS 157 & 158 PART
