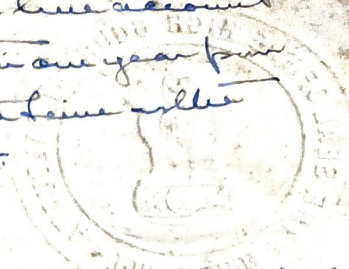

This is the last will and Testament of my Madan
Mohan Dhan son of Tulsi Das Dhan deceased Hindu
Landholder residing at No. 7 B Jodunandan Goswami
Lane in the town of Calcutta

I hereby revoke all wills and Testamentary disposi-
tions, if any made by me previously

1. I have become old. I have my wife named Sri
Annapurna Dhan and seven sons. Bheswanath Dhan
Bholanath Dhan, Tarakanath Dhan, Kedarnath Dhan
Kasinath Dhan, Bijaynath Dhan and Derigacharan
Dhan and two daughters named Sri Gami Bala Dey
and Sri Lakhi Sona Dey. Both of my said daughters are
married and they are well placed. Besides, I have
already given them sufficient money. They will
not therefore receive any property that I may leave
at the time of my death.
2. The said premises No. 7 B, Jodunandan Goswami
Lane Calcutta is my dwelling house. After my death
my said wife Sri Annapurna Dhan shall have life
interest in the said premises. She will be at liberty
to permit my sons (other than my son Kedarnath Dhan
who is now residing in a separate house) with their
children to reside with her in the said premises
and those sons who will reside in the said premises

shall be bound to pay the taxes and expenses for repairs of the said premises during his life time. After the death of my said wife the said premises No 7 B. Jadanandan Goswami Lane shall vest in and be bought to my three sons Birwanath Dhan, Taraknath Dhan and Durga Charan Dhan absolutely in equal shares subject to the right of residence of the two daughters Shree Shree Radha Damodar Jais and Shree Shree Lakshmi Thakurani hereinafter mentioned

3. I have installed two deities named Shree Shree Radha Damodar Jais and Shree Shree Lakshmi Thakurani in my dwelling house at premises No 7 B. Jadanandan Goswami Lane. They are located in a room in the third story of the said premises. They shall have the right to reside in the said room forever.

4. The Puja of Shree Shree Jagat Shakti Mata is being performed and celebrated annually at my said dwelling house at 7 B. Jadanandan Goswami Lane for about sixty years last. I wish that after my death all my sons shall continue to perform the Puja of the said two deities Shree Shree Radha Damodar Jais and Shree Shree Lakshmi Mata Thakurani and shall celebrate annually the Puja of Shree Shree Jagat Shakti Mata in ^{the} same style and manner in which I have been doing I desire and wish that my said wife and after her death my sons who will get the said property shall allow the Puja of Shree Shree Jagat Shakti Mata to be performed and celebrated at the said premises annually

5. I transfer and convey the premises No 232, Bayman Road

Read. Manicktolla Calcutta to the Executors of this will upon
Trust To Hold the same during the natural life of my
said wife and to let out the said premises and the
burthens to pay the Taxes and other impositions of the
said premises and the expenses of repairs and collection
of rents and other outgoings thereof and then to pay the
balances of the rents to my said wife during her life
time for her own use and for meeting the expenses of
the Pujah of the said two deities Shree Shree Radha
Damsodari and Shree Shree Lakshmi Mata Thakurani
After the death of my said wife the said premises shall
belong to my said three sons Bholanath Dhan Karinath
Dhan and Bijaynath Dhan in equal shares absolutely
and if necessary the executors of this will shall trans-
fer the said premises in favour of my said three sons
(or their heirs in the case maybe) in equal shares. The
heir of my deceased son shall jointly get the share
of the deceased son.

6. After my death I give and bequeath the premises No.
2321, Bagmati Road, Manicktolla Calcutta, to my said
six sons Bholanath Dhan, Karinath Dhan, Bijaynath
Dhan; Biswanath Dhan; Tarakanath Dhan and Durga
Charan Dhan absolutely in equal shares.

7. After my death the Executors of this will shall
within a year after obtaining Probate of this will pay to my
son Kedarnath Dhan, absolutely the sum of Rs. 15000/-
(Rupees Fifteen thousand) out of my estate.

8. I give the rest and residue of my properties (both
movable and immovable) to my said seven sons
Biswanath Dhan, Bholanath Dhan, Tarakanath Dhan
Kedarnath Dhan, Karinath Dhan, Bijaynath Dhan
and

and Durgacharan Dhan absolutely in equal shares.

9. The Executors of my will shall out of my estate paying just debts, the actual funeral expenses and death expenses (such death expenses not to exceed Rs 2000/-) estate duty and testamentary expenses.

10. I appoint my sons Birwanath Dhan, Bholanath Dhan and Taraknath Dhan to be the Executors of this will. In witness whereof, I have hereunto set and subscribed my hand this 28th day of September 1959.
