[Section 205 of the Indian Succession Act, 1925.]





THIS IS THE LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT of me, MOHINDRA DAS, son of Ashutosh Das, deceased Hindu, landholder residing at premises No. 144, Ezra Road, Calcutta.

I. I hereby revoke and cancel all Wills and Codicils heretofore made by me and declare this to be my last Will.

II(a). I am the absolute owner of Premises No. 144, Ezra Road, Calcutta and have some movable properties. The ground floor of the said premises hereinafter referred to as "dwelling house" has been let out to tenants yielding an income of Rs. 600/- per month and the first floor thereof is being occupied by me and the members of my family.

(b). The northern portion of the said premises being a vacant piece of land is the subject matter of an Award dated 22nd January, 1955 made by Registrar Lal Bahadur under which the said portion of the said premises has to be let out to one Mr. Harish Chandra Agarwal in accordance with and subject to the terms, conditions and covenants contained in the said award and/or income to be paid on the said Award.

(c). For marriage expenses of my daughter Sunita and other personal expenses, I have taken loans of the aggregate sum of Rs. 15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen thousand) only from time to time from my second son Sisir Kumar Das promising to repay the said loans to him with interest.

interest at the rate of six per cent per annum. I have not been able to repay the said debt to him.

III. I have five sons Ajit Kumar Dey, Sisir Kumar Dey, Mihir Kumar Dey, Pradyut Kumar Dey and Jayat Kumar Dey and six daughters Namita Chosh, Sabita Dey, Snigdha Mitra, Sipra Dey, Subhra Dey and Mohua Dey. My wife Sri Kanaklata Dey is alive.

IV. I appoint Srimati Kanaklata Dey, my wife Sri Ajit Kumar Dey and Sri Sisir Kumar Dey, my sons as --- Executors of this my last Will and Testament. The said Executors shall act jointly in carrying out the directions contained in this my last Will and in case of --- difference of opinion amongst them the opinion of the majority shall prevail.

V. The Executors shall obtain Probate of this my last Will from appropriate Court without furnishing any security and shall pay the testamentary expenses and all my just debts including the loans mentioned in --- clause II(c) hereof and funeral and Gradh expenses out of my estate.

VI. I have already made a gift of my business to Ajit and Mihir my first and third sons respectively. My second son Sisir is well established in life. My fourth and fifth sons Pradyut and Jayat are young. Pradyut is in service and Jayat is still a student. My first and third daughters Namita and Snigdha are married in well-to-do families. My second daughter Sabita is religious minded and has expressed her willingness not to marry.

I have yet to give my three youngest daughters, Sipra, Subhra and Mohua in marriage.

VII. I will and direct that my said wife shall be entitled to live and reside in the first floor of the said dwelling house for and during the term of her natural life. Provided that if she so consents in writing the Executors shall be at liberty to let out the first floor of the said dwelling house for augmenting income of my estate.

VIII. Subject to the provisions contained in -- Clause VII and XII(3) hereof I give and bequeath my property being premises No. 51A, Hawra Road to my five sons absolutely for ever and in equal shares.

IX. I direct that the Executors shall call in and collect all my assets and realise all rents issues profits income and moneys payable to my estate and there-cut pay the municipal taxes, revenue, costs of repairs and all necessary outgoings in respect of my said dwelling house or any portion thereof. I further direct that after the said disbursements and payments and/or adequate provisions being made therefor the net income of my estate shall be dealt with and disbursed as follows :-

(a) My wife if she survives me will be entitled during her natural life to a monthly annuity of such sum as will represent 25% of the monthly net income of my estate. The first instalment of such monthly annuity will be payable within one month after my death.

(b) 50% of the monthly net income of my estate shall





shall be accumulated and out of accumulations together with accretions thereto the following disbursements --- shall be made.

- (i) Aggregate sum of Rs.20,000/- shall be paid and spend for and towards marriage expenses of my three youngest daughters Sipra, Subhra and Mohua;
- (ii) Rs.6,000/- shall be paid and spent for and ---- towards marriage expenses my daughter Sabita if she marries before completion of marriages of my said three youngest daughters. On completion of the marriages of my three youngest --- daughters, if Sabita wishes to remain a spinster she will be absolutely entitled to the said sum of Rs.6,000/- which is hereby bequeathed to her;
- (iii) The remaining 25% of the monthly net income shall be accumulated and set apart by the executors and on completion of marriages of my said three youngest daughters or upon the death of my wife which ever shall happen later but not beyond the period of 18 years from my death my daughters who will be living at that time will be entitled to receive as a lump sum the 25% of the monthly net income of my estate together with accretion thereto in equal -- shares.

Be it known that payment of the said lump sum of 25% shall at no time be made out of the corpus of my --- estate and shall not be made until my said loans of --- Rs.16,000/- (Rupees Sixteen thousand only) payable to Sir with int rest as aforesaid are repaid in full.



X. I will and direct that 75% of the total net income of my estate made up of 50% mentioned in Clause IX(b) and 25% mentioned in Clause IX(c) shall be invested by the Executors in their names as Executors in the State Bank of India or in any other Trustee-securities until the respective payments provided for in Clause IX(b) and (c) hereof are required to be made according to the provisions hereof.

XI(a) I will and direct that my fourth son Pradyut will be entitled to receive Rs.5,000/- out of what has heretofore been bequeathed to my eldest son Ajit and my fifth son Jayat will be entitled to receive Rs.5,000/- out of what has heretofore been bequeathed to my third son Nihir.

(b) Payments of the said two respective sums of -- Rs.5,000/- to Pradyut and Jayat respectively shall form first charge on the respective bequests to Ajit and Nihir.

XII. I will and direct that the following shall form part of my residuary estate:

(1) On the death of my wife 25% of the total net income of my estate mentioned in Clause IX(a) hereof;


(2) In the event of any of my daughters dying unmarried the amount which, as hereinbefore provided, would have been payable her marriage expenses;

(3) In the event of any of my sons dying unmarried before my death his share in my estate together with income accretions and accumulations;

(4) All benefits and rights under and in accordance with the said Award and the decree thereon referred to in Clause II hereof.

XIII. I give and bequeath all the rest and residue of my estate including the properties mentioned in XIII(1), (2), (3) and (4) hereof and all income accumulations and accretions to all my property and all my properties movable and immovable whatsoever which I may die possessed of and in respect of which I have power of disposition by Will but not otherwise disposed of by this my Will unto my sons absolutely for ever and in equal shares;


