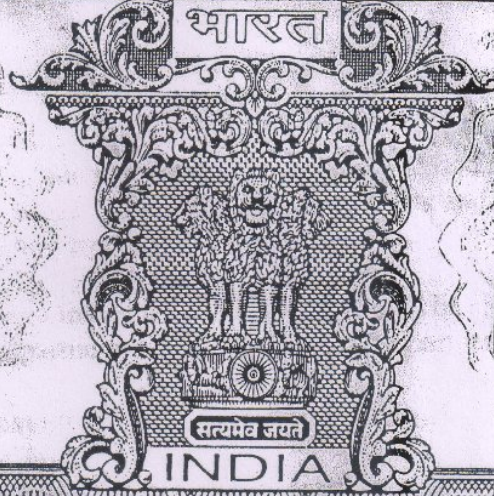

DISSOLUTION DEED

THIS DEED OF DISSOLUTION PARTNERSHIP IS MADE THIS 1ST DAY OF NOVEMBER, 2008 (TWO THOUSAND EIGHT) BETWEEN
