

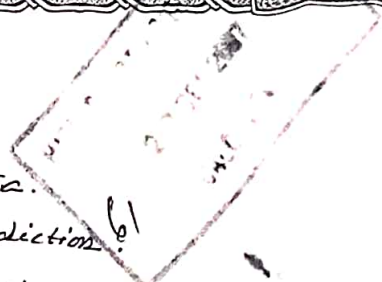

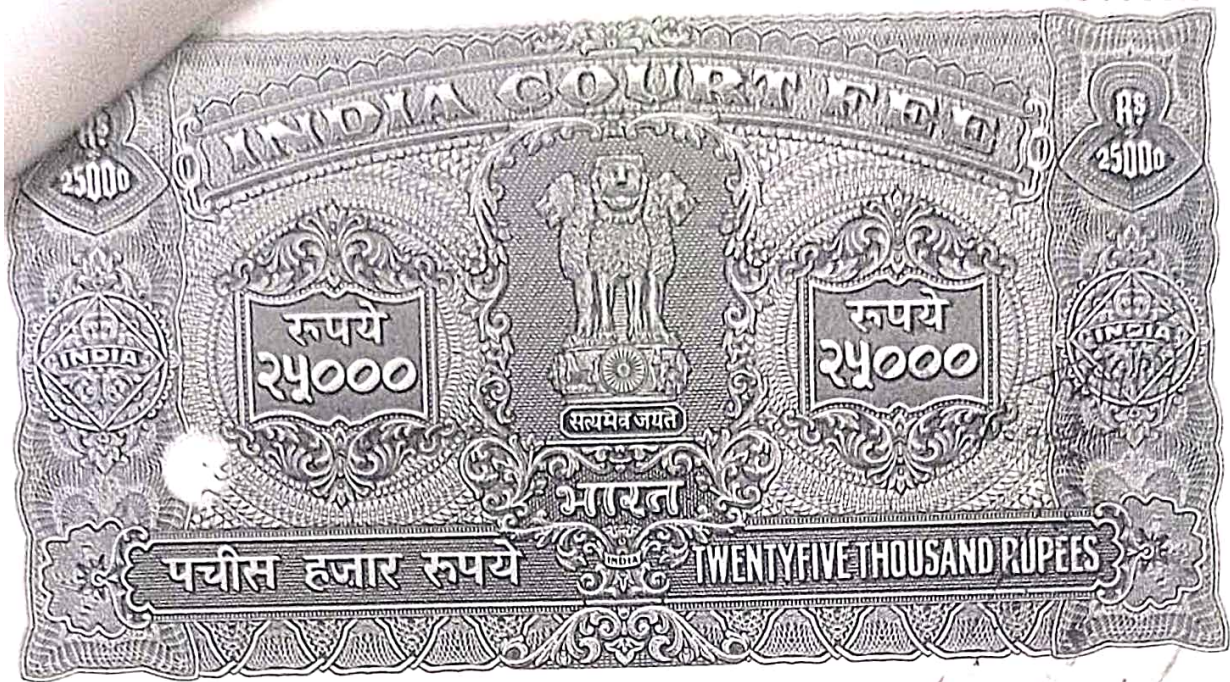

This is the last will and Testament of me, Pashupati Nath Paul, son of Bhatnath Paul deceased, by faith-Hindu, by occupation-Landlord, residing at Nos. 77 and 77/1, Benikola Street, in the town of Calcutta-700005, I hereby revoke all previous wills and Testamentary dispositions if anything heretofore made by me and declare this is to be my last will and Testament, This will should be operative after my death.

Whereas I am absolutely seized and possessed of or otherwise well and sufficiently entitled to as and for an estate of inheritance in fee simple in possession or an estate analogous thereto all that brick built messuages tenements hereditaments and premises together with the land thereunto belonging being No. 55, Gurusada Haldar Road formerly known and numbered as 55/56, Helderpara Road, Calcutta-700026 (hereinafter referred to as the "said premises" which described in the schedule hereunder written). I am also possessing other moveable and immoveable properties in the town of Calcutta.

And whereas my family now consists of three married sons namely Prasanta Kumar Paul, Pratap Chandra Paul and Mohin Kumar Paul who are all residing with me. I have a widowed daughter Smt. Purabi Devi, widow of Tapan Kumar Devi deceased residing at No. 31, Arjit Mistry Lane in the town of Calcutta. My wife Smt. Annapurna Paul predeceased me. I have made separate provisions for succession of my other moveable and immoveable properties for my said sons and daughter. They are entitled to get my movable and immoveable properties which I possess and of which I have not made any provisions for succession thereof after my death

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equally save and except the said Premises/ property which more fully and particularly described in the schedule hereunder herein. I am making this my last will and Testament only in respect of the said Premises which more fully and particularly mentioned in the schedule hereunder herein.

And whereas I have already attained the age of about 84 years and am suffering from different illnesses and it is now necessary for me to make effective provisions for succession to my said Premises in accordance with my this will and Testament when I am no more.

Now Therefore

1. I direct that my executor hereinafter named pay and discharge all of my just debt and expenses.

2. I hereby give, devise and bequeath unto one of my grand son Sri Priyadip Kumar Paul, son of Sri Prasanta Kumar Paul residing with me, all that my said Premises, Property and estate which more fully and particularly mentioned and described in the schedule hereunder herein of whatsoever nature or whatsoever situated, to have and to hold the same absolutely for ever with the absolute discretion and liberty to dispose of the same by way of sale, gift, mortgage, transfer etc.

3. I hereby nominate, constitute and appoint to Sri Prasanta Kumar Paul my eldest son as the Sole Executor of my last will and Testament who will be entitled to obtain probate from appropriate court without being required to furnish any security.
