(3) The complaint shall be accompanied by a fee, as specified in the table given below, in the form of crossed Demand Draft drawn on a nationalised bank or through crossed Indian Postal Order drawn in favour of the President of the concerned Forum or the Registrar, State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, as applicable.
