INDEPENDENT AUDITOR' REPORT

TO THE MEMBERS OF EARTHWORK NIRMAN PRIVATE LIMITED

Report on the Financial Statements

We have audited the accompanying financial statements of Earthwork Nirman Pvt. Ltd. ("the Company") of Akash Niloy Housing Complex, Flat No. 1, Block – C/1, Ground Floor, Narayanpur, Rajarhat, Kolkata-7001 36 which comprises the Balance Sheet as at March 31, 2018, the Statement of Profit and Loss Statement for the year then ended, and a summary of significant accounting policies and other explanatory information.

Management's Responsibility for the Financial Statements

The Company's Board of Directors is responsible for the matters stated in Section 134(5) of the Companies Act, 2013 ("the Act") with respect to the preparation of these financial statements that give a true and fair view of the financial position, financial performance of the Company in accordance with the accounting principles generally accepted in India, including the Accounting Standards specified under Section 133 of the Act, read with Rule 7 of the Companies (Accounts) Rules, 2014. This responsibility also includes maintenance of adequate accounting records in accordance with the provisions of the Act for safeguarding the assets of the Company and for preventing and detecting frauds and other irregularities; selection and application of appropriate accounting policies; making judgments and estimates that are reasonable and prudent; and design, implementation and maintenance of adequate internal financial controls, that were operating effectively for ensuring the accuracy and completeness of the accounting records, relevant to the preparation and presentation of the financial statements that give a true and fair view and are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

Auditor's Responsibility

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audit.

We have taken into account the provisions of the Act, the accounting and auditing standards and matters which are required to be included in the audit report under the provisions of the Act and the Rules made there under.

We conducted our audit in accordance with the Standards on Auditing specified under Section 143(10) of the Act. Those Standards require that we comply with ethical requirements and plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free from material misstatement.





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An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and the disclosures in the financial statements. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgment, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the financial statements, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal financial control relevant to the Company's preparation of the financial statements that give a true and fair view in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of the accounting policies used and the reasonableness of the accounting estimates made by the Company's Directors, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the financial statements.

Report on Other Legal and Regulatory Requirements

 - d. in our opinion, the aforesaid financial statements comply with the Accounting Standards specified under section 133 of the Act, read with Rule 7 of the Companies (Accounts) Rules, 2014.



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- e. On the basis of written representations received from the directors as on March 31, 2018 taken on record by the Board of Directors, none of the directors is disqualified as on March 31, 2018 from being appointed as a director in terms of Section 164 (2) of the Act.
- f. With respect to the adequacy of the internal financial controls over financial reporting of the Company and the operating effectiveness of such controls, refer to our separate Report in "AnnexureB". Our report expresses an unmodified opinion on the adequacy and operating effectiveness of the Company's internal financial controls over financial reporting.
- g. With respect to the other matters to be included in the Auditor's Report in accordance with Rule 11 of the Companies (Audit and Auditors) Rules, 2014, in our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us:
 - i. The Company does not have any pending litigations which would impact its financial position.
 - ii. The Company did not have any long-term contracts including derivative contracts for which there were any material foreseeable losses.
 - iii. There were no amounts which were required to be transferred to the Investor Education and Protection Fund by the Company.

Annexure Referred to in paragraph no 1 under the heading 'Report on Other Legal & Regulatory Requirement' of our report of even date to the financial statements of the Earthwork Nirman Private Limited for the year ended on 31st March 2018.

We report that:

- Having Regard to the size of the operation of the company, on the basis of information and explanations given to us by the management and based upon the records examined by us, in our opinion;
 - a) The company has maintained proper records showing full particulars including quantitative details and situation of fixed assets.
 - b) The company has a regular program for the physical verification of the fixed assets at periodic intervals. The period of verifications is reasonable having regard to the size of the company and nature of its assets. No significant discrepancies were noticed on such verification.
 - c) The title deeds of immovable properties are held in the name of the company.
- 2) According to information and explanations given by the management and on the basis of our examination, we are of the opinion that the closing Stock of the company comprises of Work in Progress (WIP), valued at cost as on 31st march 2018. The balance of direct expenses from which no substantial revenue have been generated in this financial year, i.e.2017-2018, have been taken as WIP as on 31.03.2018.
- 3) According to information and explanations given by the management and on the basis of our examination, we are of the opinion that during the year the company has not granted any loans, secured or unsecured to companies, firms, Limited Liability partnerships or other parties covered in the Register maintained under section 189 of the Act. Accordingly, the provisions of clause 3 (iii) (a) to (C) of the Order are not applicable to the Company and hence not commented upon.

However, as per information & explanations provided to us by the management, the company has entered into Agreement and given capital advances in this regard to one of the directors and to 2 (Two) companies in which one of the directors of the company is a director & also to 1 (One) company in which relative of one of the directors of the company is a director. In our opinion and according to the information and explanations given to us and according to the agreements, resolution passed in the EGM by the shareholders and documents produced before us this capital advance is not in the nature of Loan. The terms and conditions of the contract are not prejudicial to the company's interest.





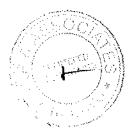

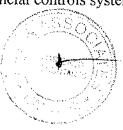

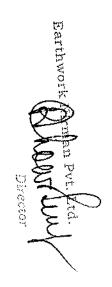
