



PARTY'S COPY

Plan for Water Supply arrangement including SEMLI G. & O. H. reservoirs should be submitted at the Office of the Ex-Engineer Water Supply and the sanction obtained before proceeding with the work of Water Supply any deviation may lead to disconnection/demolition.

CONSTRUCTION SITE SHALL BE MAINTAINED TO PREVENT MOSQUITO BREEDING AS REQUIRED UNDER 114 (2) OF C.M.C. ACT 1988. IN SUCH MANNER SO THAT ALL WATER COLLECTION & PARTICULARLY LIFT WELLS, VATS, BASEMENT CURING SITES, OPEN RECEPTACLES ETC. MUST BE EMPTIED COMPLETELY TWICE A WEEK.

Design of all Structural Members including that of the foundation should conform to Standards specified in the National Building Code of India.

All Building Materials to necessary & construction should conform to standards specified in the National Building Code of India.

Necessary steps should be taken for the safety of the lives of the adjoining public and private properties during construction.

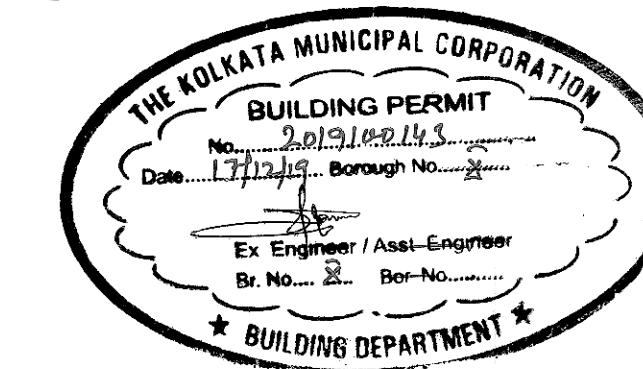
Non Commencement of Erection/Re-Erection within Five year will Require Fresh Application for Sanction

DEVIATION WOULD MEAN DEMOLITION

RESIDENTIAL BUILDING

A suitable pump has to be provided i.e. pumping unfiltered water for the distribution to the flushing cisterns and urinals in the building increase unfiltered water from street main is not available.

The Building materials that will be stacked on Road/Passage or Foot-path beyond 3-months or after construction of G. Floor, whichever is earlier may be seized forthwith by the K.M.C. at the cost and risk of the owner.



THE SANCTION IS VALID UP TO 17/12/2019

Sanctioned subject to demolition of existing structure to provide open space as per plan before construction is started

No rain water pipe should be fixed or discharged on Road or Footpath. Drainage plan should be submitted at the Borough Executive Engineer's Office and the sanction obtained before proceeding with the drainage work.


Any unauthorised construction done in deviation from the Sanction Building permit and the Completion Plans after issuance of this Completion Plans may cause revocation of the Occupancy Certificate.

Sanctioned conditionally on an undertaking duly registered from the owner's to the effect till they will not evict any tenants & will also provide the tenants with identical area in and around the premises by mutual arrangements.

- Precautions measures need to be taken for pollution free environment:-
1. Where construction area building with portable fabric installing dust barriers, or other actions, as appropriate for the location.
 2. Apply water and materials such as a vehicle being or covered condition for temporary stabilisation.
 3. Apply water prior to loading or any other earth moving activity to keep the soil moist throughout the process.
 4. Limit vehicle speeds to 15 mph on the work site.
 5. Clean wheels and undercarriage of all trucks prior to leaving construction site.
 6. Apply wet sweeping dust suppression on haul roads.
 7. Apply a cover or sheet to discharge and receive materials during completion of activity by water and suitable surface with water hoses, support equipment and vehicles will operate by using water and suitable surface and in a different condition where hoses, support equipment and vehicles will maintain surface and in a different condition where hoses, support equipment and vehicles will maintain surface.
 8. Maintain adequate disturbed soil following paving activities with immediate landscaping activity or stabilisation of vegetation or rock cover.
 9. Maintain a control during working hours and clean tracks out from paved surfaces at the end of the work day. Tracks out must now extend 50 feet or more and must be cleaned daily, at the minimum.
