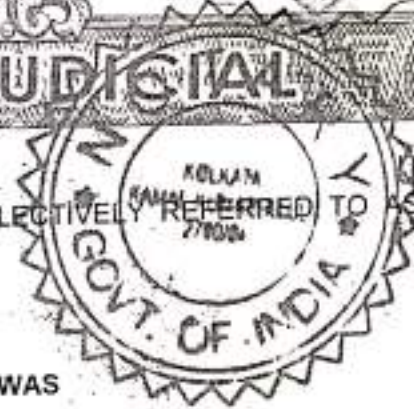

4. The Contribution of the **M/S. BISWAS INFRACON LLP** shall be Rs. 10,00,000 (Rupees Ten Lakh only) which shall be contributed by the partners in the following proportions.

The further Contribution if any required by the M/S. **BISWAS INFRACON LLP** shall be brought by the partners in their profit sharing ratio.



5. The M/S. **BISWAS INFRACON LLP** shall have a common seal to be affixed on documents as defined by partners under the signature of any of the Designated Partners.

6. The business of the M/S. **BISWAS INFRACON LLP** shall be of **CONSTRUCTION AND INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT**.

7. That the immovable properties purchased by the LLP shall be clear, marketable and free from all encumbrances.

8. The net profits of the **BISWAS INFRACON LLP** arrived at after providing for payment of remuneration to the working partners **BARIK BISWAS** and **FARIDA BEGUM BISWAS** and interest to partners on the loan given by them shall be divided in the following proportions:

9. The losses of the M/S. **BISWAS INFRACON LLP** including loss of capital, if any, shall be borne and paid by the partners in the following proportions:

10. The bankers of the partnership shall be any nationalized and/or private Bank and/or such other bank or banks as the partners may from time to time unanimously agreed upon.

11. The business of the M/S. **BISWAS INFRACON LLP** are as followed:

1. To purchase any land, plot(s) of land or immovable property or any right or interest therein either singly or jointly or in Partnership with any person(s) or Body corporate or partnership Firm and to develop and construct thereon residential, commercial complex or complex (es) either singly or jointly or in partnership as aforesaid, comprising offices for sale or self use or for earning rental income thereon by letting out individual units comprised in such building(s).

2. To purchase any movable or immovable property including industrial, commercial, residential, or farm lands, plots, buildings, houses, apartments, flats or areas within

or outside the limits of Municipal Corporation or other local bodies, anywhere within the Domain of India, to divide the same into suitable plots, and to rent or sell the plots for building/constructing residential houses, bungalows, business premises, and colonies and rent or sell the same and realize cost in lump sum or easy installments or by hire purchase system and otherwise.



3. To purchase, sell and otherwise to carry on the business such as builders, contractors, architects, engineers, Estate agents, decorators and surveyors.

4. To purchase for resale and to trade in land and house and other immovable property of any tenure and any interest therein, and to create, sell and deal in freehold and leasehold ground rents, and to deal in trade by way of sale, or otherwise with land and house property and any other immovable property whether real or personal.

5. To construct, execute, carryout, equip, support maintain, operate, improve, work, Develop, administer, manage, control and superintend within or outside the country anywhere in the world all kinds of works, public or otherwise, buildings, houses and other constructions or conveniences of all kinds, which expression in this memorandum includes roads, railways, and tramways, docks, harbours, Piers, wharves, canals, serial runways and hangers, airports, reservoirs, embankments, irrigations, reclamation, improvements, sewage, sanitary, water, gas, electronic light, power supply works, and hotels, cold storages, warehouses, cinema houses, markets, public and other buildings and all other works and conveniences of public or private utility, to apply for purchase or otherwise acquire any contracts, decrease, concessions, for or in relation to the construction, execution, carrying out equipment, improvement, administration, or control of all such works and conveniences as aforesaid and to undertake, execute, carry out, dispose of or otherwise turn to account the same.

AND other ancillary business more particularly described in the Schedule 1 annexed herewith or any other business in any other manner as may be decided by the majority of Partners.

Admission of New Partner

12. The new partner may not be introduced without the consent of all the existing partners. Such incoming partner shall give his prior consent to act as Partner of the **M/S. BISWAS INFRACON LLP.**
13. The Profit sharing ratio of the incoming partner will be in proportion to his contribution towards **M/S. BISWAS INFRACON LLP.**

Rights of Partner

- All the partners hereto shall have the rights, title and interest in all the assets and properties in the said M/S. **BISWAS INFRACON LLP** in the proportion of their Contribution.
15. Every partner has a right to have access to and to inspect and copy any books of the M/S. **BISWAS INFRACON LLP**.
16. Each of the parties hereto shall be entitled to carry on their own, separate and independent business as hitherto they might be doing or they may hereafter do as they deem fit and proper and other partners and the M/S. **BISWAS INFRACON LLP** shall have no objection thereto provided that the said partner has intimated the said fact to the M/S. **BISWAS INFRACON LLP** before the start of the independent business and moreover he shall not use the name of the M/S. **BISWAS INFRACON LLP** to carry on the said business.
17. If any partner shall advance any sum of money to M/S. **BISWAS INFRACON LLP** over and above his due contribution to capital, the same shall be a debt due from the M/S. **BISWAS INFRACON LLP** to the partner advancing the same and shall carry simple interest at the rate of 12% per annum or any other rate decided by the partners unanimously.
18. M/S. **BISWAS INFRACON LLP** shall have perpetual succession. So, death, retirement or insolvency of any partner shall not dissolve the M/S. **BISWAS INFRACON LLP**.
19. On retirement of a partner, the retiring partner shall be entitled to full payment in respect of all his rights, title and interest in the partner as herein provided. However, upon insolvency of a partner his or her rights, title and interest in the M/S. **BISWAS INFRACON LLP** shall come to an end. Upon the death of any of the partners herein any one of his or her heirs will be admitted as a partner of the M/S. **BISWAS INFRACON LLP** in place of such deceased partner. The heirs, executors and administrators of such deceased partners shall be entitled to and shall be paid the full payment in respect of the right, title and interest of such deceased partner.
20. On the death of any partner, if his or her heir opts not to become the partner, the surviving partners shall have the option to purchase the contribution of the deceased partner in the M/S **BISWAS INFRACON LLP**.



Duties of Partners

21. Each Partner shall be just and faithful to the other partners in all transactions relating to the LLP.
22. Each partner shall render true accounts and full information of all things affecting the limited liability partnership to any partner or his legal representatives.

26. No Partner shall without the written consent of other Partners :-

- Engage or except for gross misconduct, dismiss any employee of the partnership
- Employ any money, goods or effects of the partnership or pledge the credit thereof except in the ordinary course of business and upon the account or for the benefit of the M/S. **BISWAS INFRACON LLP**.
- Enter into any bond or become sureties or security with or for any person or do knowingly cause or suffer to be done anything whereby the partnership property or any part thereof may be seized.
- Assign, mortgage or charge his or her share in the partnership or any asset or property thereof or make any other person a partner therein.
- Engage directly or indirectly in any business competing with that of the limited liability partnership.
- Lend money or give credit on behalf of the M/S. **BISWAS INFRACON LLP** or to have any dealings with any persons, company or firm whom the other partner previously in writing have forbidden it to trust or deal with. Any loss incurred through any breach of provisions shall be made good with the M/S. **BISWAS INFRACON LLP** by the partner incurring the same.
- Compromise or compound or (except upon payment in full) release or discharge any debt due to the M/S. **BISWAS INFRACON LLP** except upon the written consent given by the other partner.

Meeting

27. The meeting of designated partners may be called by giving 7 days notice. In case if any urgent meeting is called the notice requirement is to be rectified by all the Partners.

- The matter discussed in the M/S. **BISWAS INFRACON LLP** meeting shall be decided by a resolution passed by a majority in number of the partners, and for this purpose, each partner shall have one vote.
29. The meeting of the Partners may be called by sending 7 days prior notice to all the partners at their residential address or in case of urgent meeting the same can be called by telephonic conversation but the notice requirement is to be complied by all the Partners.
30. The meeting of Partners shall ordinarily be held at the registered office of the M/S. **BISWAS INFRACON LLP** or at any other place as per the convenience of partners.
31. Every limited liability partnership shall ensure that decisions taken by it are recorded in the minutes within 30 days of taking such decisions and are kept and maintained at the registered office of the M/S. **BISWAS INFRACON LLP**.
32. Each partner shall--
- I. Punctually pay and discharge the separate debts and engagement and indemnify the other partners and the M/S. **BISWAS INFRACON LLP** assets against the same and all proceedings, costs, claims and demands in respect thereof.
 - II. Each of the partners shall give time and attention as may be required for the fulfillment of the objectives of the M/S. **BISWAS INFRACON LLP** business and they all shall be the working partners.

Duties of Designated Partner

33. The Authorised representative of First Party and the Second Party shall act as the Designated Partner of the M/S. **BISWAS INFRACON LLP** in terms of the requirement of the Limited Liability Partnership Act, 2008.
34. The Designated Partners shall be responsible for the doing of all acts, matters and things as are required to be done by the limited liability partnership in respect of compliance of the provisions of this Act including filing of any document, return, statement and the like report pursuant to the provisions of Limited Liability Partnership Act, 2008.
35. The Designated Partners shall be responsible for the doing of all acts arising out of this agreement.
36. No remuneration will be given to any of the Designated Partner for rendering of their services.
37. The M/S. **BISWAS INFRACON LLP** shall indemnify and defend its partners and other officers from and against any and all liability in connection with claims, actions and proceedings (regardless of the outcome), judgment, loss or settlement thereof, whether civil or criminal, arising out of or resulting from their respective performances as partners and officers of the M/S. **BISWAS INFRACON LLP**, except for the gross negligence or willful misconduct of the partner or officer seeking indemnification.

Termination of Existing Partners

38. Partner may cease to be partner of the M/S. **BISWAS INFRACON LLP** by giving a notice in writing of not less than 60 days to the other partners of his intention to resign as partner.
39. No majority of Partners can expel any partner except in the situation where any partner has been found guilty of carrying of activity/business of M/S. **BISWAS INFRACON LLP** with fraudulent purpose.
40. The M/S. **BISWAS INFRACON LLP** can be wound up with the consent of all the partners subject to the provisions of Limited Liability Partnership Act 2008.



Extent of Liability of M/S. **BISWAS INFRACON LLP**

41. M/S. **BISWAS INFRACON LLP** is not bound by anything done by a partner in dealing with a person if—
- the partner in fact has no authority to act for the M/S. **BISWAS INFRACON LLP** in doing a particular act; and
 - the person knows that he has no authority or does not know or believe him to be a partner of the M/S. **BISWAS INFRACON LLP**.

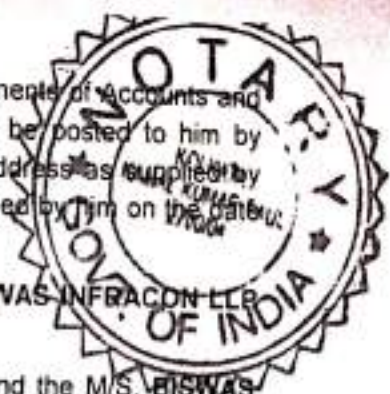
Miscellaneous Provisions

42. The limited liability partnership shall indemnify each partner in respect of payments made and personal liabilities incurred by him—
- in the ordinary and proper conduct of the business of the limited liability partnership; or
 - in or about anything necessarily done for the preservation of the business or property of the limited liability partnership.
43. The books of accounts of the firm shall be kept at the registered office of the M/S. **BISWAS INFRACON LLP** for the reference of all the partners.

45. The Designated Partners of the LLP shall, within a period of six months from the end of each financial year, prepare the Annual Statements of Accounts and Solvency for the financial year as at its last day of all the capital contributions, assets and liabilities and of the profits and losses of the LLP, and the same shall be signed by each Partner in addition to the signing thereof by the Designated partners of the LLP as required under section 34(2) of the Act in token of his being bound thereby.

To carry on business as, importers, exporters, traders, buyers, sellers, retailers, wholesalers, suppliers, indenters, packers, movers, preservers, stockists, agents, sub-agents, merchants, distributors, consignors, jobbers, brokers, concessionaires or otherwise deal in all types and varieties of storage batteries, dry or otherwise, for all kinds of uses, battery plates, cells, battery components, chargers, motors, transformer, stabilizers and all other kinds of electronic components, devices.

7. To carry on all or any of the businesses of designers, trader, maintainers, repairers of and dealers in electrical and electronic appliances and apparatus of every description, and of and in radio, television and telecommunication requisites and supplies, teletext and view data receivers, and electrical and electronic apparatus, appliances, equipment and stores of all kinds.

8. To acquire, purchase, take over business of firm having similar objects which under existing Circumstances, from time to time may conveniently or advantageously be combined with the business of the firm; to amalgamate with firms whose business are so acquired, purchased or taken over and/or to enter into agreements with the objects or acquisition of such undertakings and/or business.
