			<p>The petitioners' case, as appears from the writ petition, is that the Mouza should be recorded as 'Sripur Bagharghola' in place of 'Brahmapur'.</p> <p>Mr. Ray, the learned advocate for the petitioners <sup>has ventilated</sup> submits that after the petitioners <del>had</del> <del>ventilated</del> their grievance through their learned advocate, <del>they</del> they had received a telephonic message from the Refugee Relief &amp; Rehabilitation Department, Government of West Bengal intimating them that the Mouza Brahmapur has been rightly recorded but the name of the police station should be different. According to Mr. Ray, the authorities had disclosed that the police station should be 'Banshroni'. The petitioners, therefore, pray for a correction in the deed of gift otherwise the present sets of petitioners are facing problem in mutating their names after the demise of Late Santipada Ghosh.</p> <p>Mr. Mukherjee has no objection to this rectification which is most formal in nature and submits that the respondents are not willing to use any affidavit to the writ petition.</p> <p>In such view of it, the writ petition is disposed of by directing the respondent No. 1 herein to execute a deed of declaration in favour of the petitioners by rectifying the mistake in the original deed of gift dated February 8, 1991 which has been annexed to the writ petition as 'Annexure P-1' in accordance with law and upon compliance of</p>

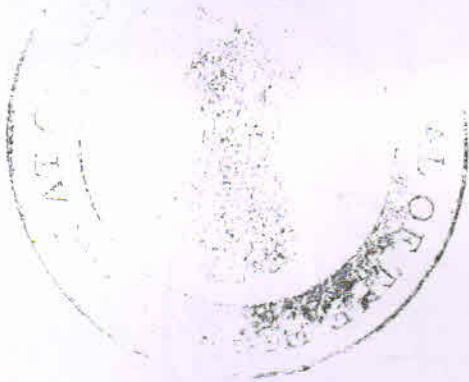
