Report on the Financial Statements

1. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

a. BASIS OF ACCOUNTING

The Financial statements are prepared under historical cost convention, on accural basis, in accordance with the generally accepted accounting principles in India and to comply with the Accounting Standard notified under section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 7 of the Companies (Accounts) Rules, 2014., to the extent applicable.

All the assets and liabilities have been classified as current and non current as per the company's normal project operating cycle and other criteria set out in Schedule III of Companies Act, 2013.

b. INVENTORIES

All Inventories are valued at cost or Net Realizable value whichever is lower.

c. PROPERTY, PLANT & EQUIPMENT

Property, Plant & Equipment are stated at cost less accumulated depreciation. Such cost includes, purchase price, borrowing cost, and any cost directly attributable to bringing the assets to its working condition for its intended use.

d. DEPRECIATION

1. Land & Building

Depreciation on Land & Building is provided using straight line method over the useful lives of assets estimated by the management which ranges from 40-50 years ⁽¹⁾. However in the previous year, the estimated useful life was in line with the requiremnets of Part C of Schedule II of the Companies Act 2013.

(1) Based on technical evaluation, the management believes that the useful live as given above best represent the period over which management expects to use that asset. Hence, the useful live is different from the useful live as prescribed under Part C of Schedule II of the Companies Act 2013.

2. Office Equipment

Depreciation on Office Equipment is provided using written down value method over the estimated useful lives of assets and are in line with the requirements of Part C of Schedule II of the Companies Act, 2013.

e. <u>INVESTMENT</u>

Non current investments are stated at cost. Diminution in value of non current investments other than temporary in nature is charged to Profit & Loss Statement. Current Investments are valued at cost or fair market value whichever is lower.

f. RETIREMENT BENEFITS

- I. Contribution to Provident Fund is made at a predetermined rate on actual basis.
- II. Liability in respect of Gratuity is made on the basis of actuarial valuation as at the year end as per the requirements of Accounting Standard-15(revised 2005) on "Employee Benefits".
