2 RESULTS OF OPERATIONS AND THE STATE OF COMPANY'S AFFAIRS

The Company is engaged in the business of real estate. There has been no change in the business of the Company during the financial year ended 31st March, 2019.

- iv. Net Profit decreased by 15.58% from ₹ 2,57,17,210.00 to ₹ 2,17,11,561.75.
- v. Earnings per share has decreased by 15.58% from ₹ 23.30 to ₹ 19.67.

Cash comprises cash in hand. Cash equivalents comprise balances in current account with banks.

1.5 Revenue recognition

Sale of goods

Sales are recognised, net of returns and trade discounts, on transfer of significant risks and rewards of ownership to the buyer, which generally coincides with the delivery of goods to customers.

1.6 Other Income

Interest income and Miscellaneous Income is accounted on accrual basis.

1.7 Depreciation

Depreciation/amortisation has been provided on the written-down value method as per the estimated useful lives prescribed in Schedule II to the Companies Act, 2013.

1.8 Property, Plant And Equipments

Fixed assets are carried at cost less accumulated depreciation. The cost of fixed assets includes interest on borrowings attributable to acquisition of qualifying fixed assets up to the date the asset is ready for its intended use and other incidental expenses incurred up to that date.

1.9 Earnings per share

Basic earnings per share is computed by dividing the profit / (loss) after tax (including the post tax effect of extraordinary items, if any) by the weighted average number of equity shares outstanding during the year.

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Taxes on income

Deferred tax is recognised on timing differences, being the differences between the taxable income and the accounting income that originate in one period and are capable of reversal in one or more subsequent periods. Deferred tax is measured using the tax rates and the tax laws enacted or substantially enacted as at the reporting date. Deferred tax liabilities are recognised for all timing differences. Deferred tax assets in respect of unabsorbed depreciation and carry forward of losses are recognised only if there is virtual certainty that there will be sufficient future taxable income available to realise such assets. Deferred tax assets are recognised for timing differences of other items only to the extent that reasonable certainty exists that sufficient future taxable income will be available against which these can be realised. Deferred tax assets and liabilities are offset if such items relate to taxes on income levied by the same governing tax laws and the Company has a legally enforceable right for such set off. Deferred tax assets are reviewed at each Balance Sheet date for their realisability.

1.11 Provisions

A provision is recognised when the Company has a present obligation as a result of past events and it is probable that an outflow of resources will be required to settle the obligation in respect of which a reliable estimate can be made. Provisions are not discounted to their present value and are determined based on the best estimate required to settle the obligation at the Balance Sheet date. These are reviewed at each Balance Sheet date and adjusted to reflect the current best estimates.

1.12 Figures of previous financial year have been regrouped wherever found necessary for better financial accounts presentation.

1.13 Goods And Service tax input credit

Goods and Service tax input credit is accounted for in the books in the period in which the underlying goods and service are received is accounted and when there is no uncertainty in availing /utilising the credits.
