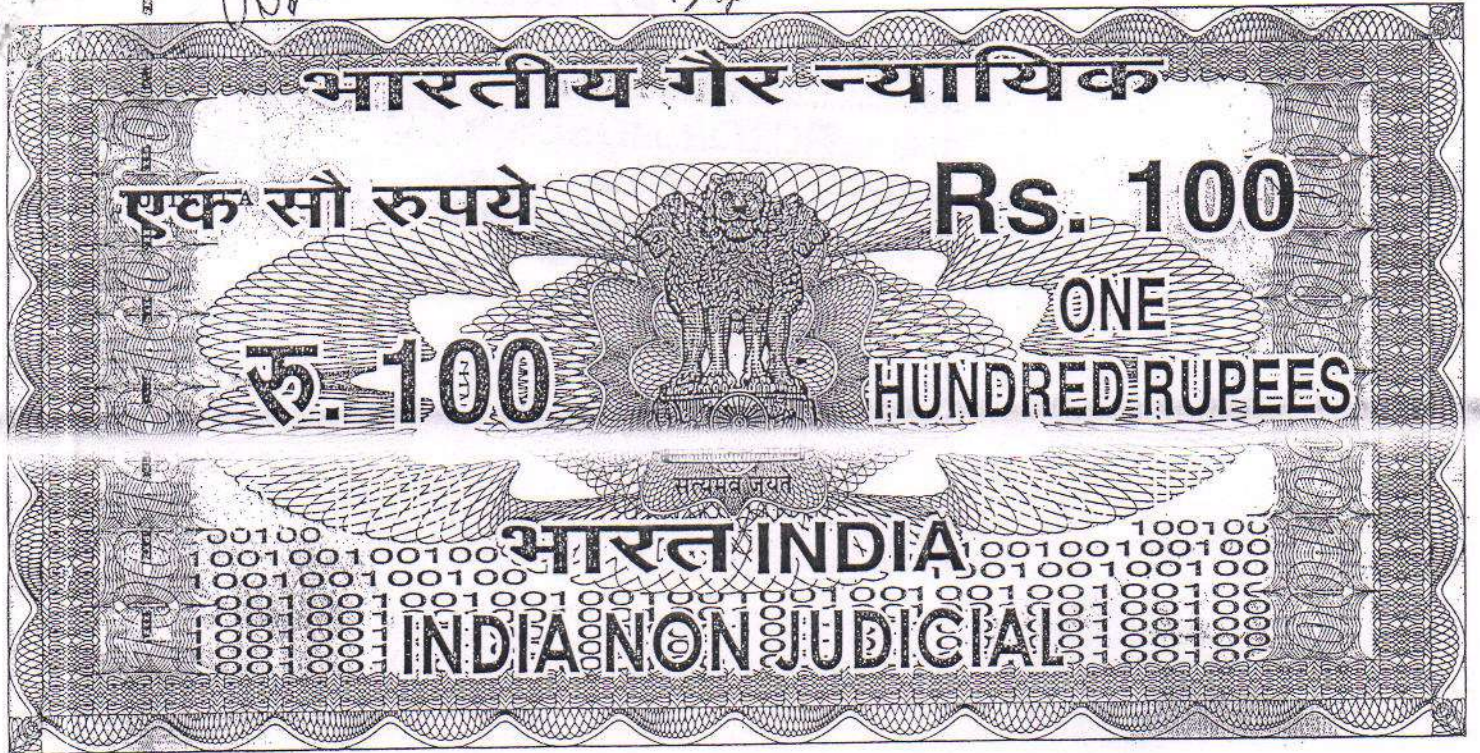

It is seen from the above that the rate of reaction increases with increasing temperature. This is to be expected since the rate of reaction is dependent on the energy of the molecules. At higher temperatures, the molecules have more energy and are therefore more likely to undergo a successful collision.

The above results are in agreement with the theory of collision theory. According to this theory, the rate of reaction is proportional to the number of molecules which possess sufficient energy to undergo a successful collision. This number increases with increasing temperature, and hence the rate of reaction increases.

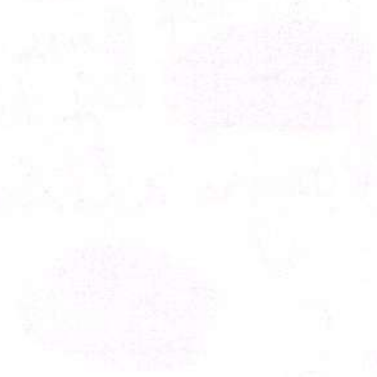
