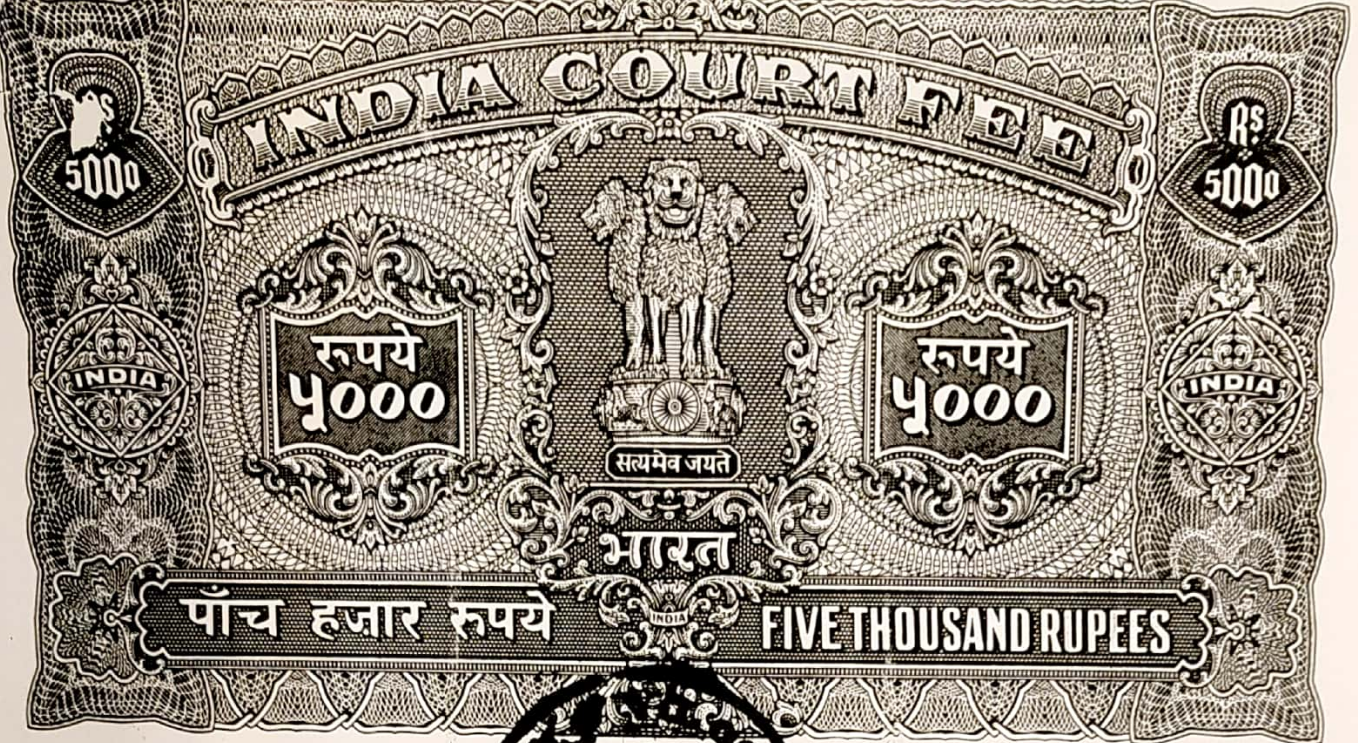

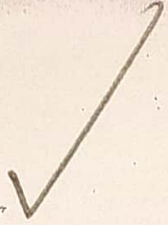

I have one son (married) namely Swarup Kumar Chowdhury and two daughters, namely Smt. Soma Basu wife of Sri Arunachia

Basu and Smt. Sampa Ghosh wife of Sri Arunabha Ghosh. To avoid any future unpleasantness amongst my son and daughters concerning my said immovable property, I have decided to make specified provisions with regard to the same.

I have made adequate provisions for my daughters and I do not feel that any further substantial provisions for them is necessary. I make, devise and bequeath my immovable property aforesaid, the dwelling house No.2/1A, Sibdas Bhaduri Street, Calcutta - 700 004, to my son to be held, owned and enjoyed by him in absolute right as owner. My said son shall have the full right to enjoy the property, with all rights incidental to ownership, including realisation of rent, settlement of tenancy etc. My said daughters shall have no claim over the said premises at No. 2/1A, Sibdas Bhaduri Street, Calcutta - 700 004.

In the event of my son pre-deceasing me, the widow of my son will take limited estate for life in the said house property and after her death the children of my said son shall inherit their father's share absolutely in equal share.

I appoint my son Sri Swarup Kumar Chowdhury, executor of this Will, who shall take out probate of this Will from Court
