After the City Council has approved the plan, the applicant must submit the plan to the Building Department for review. The Building Department will review the plan and issue a permit if the plan complies with the Building Code. If the plan does not comply, the Building Department will issue a notice of violation and the applicant must correct the plan before a permit can be issued.

A building permit is required for all construction work on a building, including but not limited to: new construction, alterations, additions, repairs, and replacements. The permit is required for all work that involves the structural integrity of the building.

Before starting any construction work, the applicant must obtain a building permit from the Building Department. The permit is required for all work that involves the structural integrity of the building.

This Building Permit is issued to the applicant for the construction of a building. The permit is valid for a period of 180 days from the date of issuance. If the work is not completed within this period, the permit must be renewed.
