Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

) Basis of Preparation:

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the generally accepted accounting principles in India under the historical cost convention on accrual basis. These financial statements have been prepared to comply, in all material aspects, with the accounting standards notified under Section 133 [Companies Act, 2013, as amended], and the other relevant provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 (the "Act").

All assets and liabilities have been classified as current or non-current as per the Company's normal operating cycle and other criteria set out in the Schedule III to the Companies Act, 2013. Based on the nature of products and the time between the acquisition of assets for processing and their realisation in eash and eash equivalents, the Company has ascertained its operating cycle as 12 months for the purpose of current/non - current classification of assets and liabilities.

The company has during the year, negative Capital Balance on account of Accumulated Lossed. However, the company is a Going Concern Entity.

b) Revenue Recognition

The company is engaged in the business of development and construction of buildings etc. on its own land. Therefore, Revenue Recognition will be done as per AS 9. Any amount received prior to the completion of the construction of building is treated as Advance (Liability).

c) Expenses :

The company follows accrual system of accounting in respect of all expenses.

d) Fixed Assets:

Fixed assets are carried out at cost of acquisition or construction, less accumulated depreciation. The cost of an item of tangible fixed asset comprises its purchase price and other non-refundable taxes or levies and any directly attributable cost of bringing assets to their working condition for their intended use. Borrowing costs directly attributable to acquisition or construction of those fixed assets which necessarily take a substantial period of time to get ready for their intended use are capitalized.

e) <u>Depreciation:</u>

Depreciation/Amortisation is provided under straight line method at the rates determined based on the useful lives of the respective assets and residual values in accordance with Schedule II of the Companies Act, 2013.

f) Inventories

Inventory consist of Land at Nakuleshwar Bhattacharya Lane. All costs directly attributable to the development of the land and construction of building has been capitalized to the value of Land. As per AS 16, "Borrowing Cost" which are directly attributable to a project have been capitalised accordingly.

g) Borrowing Cost:

Borrowing Cost that is directly attributable to the acquision or construction of qualifying asset is capitalised as part of the cost of such assets.

All other borrowing cost is charged to Revenue.

Contingent liability is a possible obligation that arises from past events and the existence of which will be confirmed only by the occurrence or non-occurrence of one or more uncertain future events not wholly within the control of the Company or is a present obligation that arises from past events but not recognized because either it is not probable that an outflow of resources embodying economic benefits will be required to settle the obligation, or the amount of the obligation cannot be reliably estimated
