I, Smt. Rita Bhattacharjee, wife of Birentra Nath Charlet and daughter of Ganesh Chandra Bhattacharjee, deceased aged about 57 years, by faith Hindu, by occupation-Housewife and at present residing at Boral-Brattacharjee Para, P.O. occupation-Housewife and at present residing at Boral-Brattacharjee Para, P.O. boral, P.S. Sonarpur, Kolkata-700 154, do hereby solemaly declare and say as follows:-

1. At all material times one Abinash Chakraborty was seized and possessed of or otherwise well and sufficiently entitled to All That piece and parcel of 'Bastu' land containing by estimation an area of 77 Sataks more or lesss out of 1.49 Satak more or less comprised in part of R. S. Dag No. 3106 of 1.49 Satak more or less comprised in part of R. S. Case No. 267 of 1988, the Learned Judge by his order dated 16th September,1988 permitted the said Ganesh Chandra Bhattacharjee, to act as sole shebait of the said deity with power to deal with the land comprised in R. S. Dag No. 3105 in discharging his function and duties as such Shebait.
- I say that on the intestate demise of the said Ganesh Chandra Bhattacharjee I along with my mothers and his other legal heirs inherited an undivided share in the assets and properties left behind by him in his individual capacity in the land comprised in R.S. Dag No. 3106 and also as the Shebait of the said deity in the land comprised in Dag No. 3105 is concerned.

Out of my own free will and without being influenced in any manner whatsoever I have now agreed to release and relinquish my right or claim in the Estate left behind by the said Ganesh Chandra Bhattacharjee (as Shebait) in respect of R. S. Dag No. 3105 and also in respect of R. S. Dag No.3016 unto and in favour of my brother viz. Asok Kumar Bhattacharjee solely, absolutely and without any reservation or claim on any account whatsoever.
