petition be deleted and the said deletion is
necessary as the abovesaid Taparia & Co
Private Limited is not being dissolved
consequent upon the modification proposed.
And it is further ordered that leave be and the
same is hereby granted to the Petitioner
companies to file a modified schedule of
assets and such schedule of assets shall

from part of this case should be given and
that all papers concerned do not on a copy
of the minutes of this case only signed by
an officer of this court being served on
them:
