



1. This sanction is valid for a period of three years from the date of sanction and may be renewed for a future period of two years or for a shorter period as provided in the Sanction Ordinance.
2. Sanction is granted on the basis of information and documents submitted by the applicant and information reported by the City of Chicago or published in a newspaper of general circulation. The City of Chicago is not responsible for the accuracy of the information submitted by the applicant or published in a newspaper of general circulation. 3. Before commencing construction the applicant must confirm to the approved sign-off. The applicant must implement all proposed and approved provisions made in the Sanction Ordinance.
