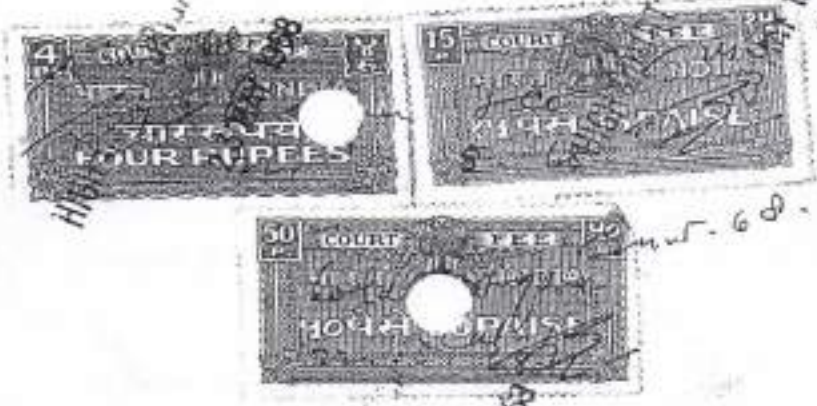

This instrument of gift is to the effect following

I am now 58 years old and will in view to making provi-
 sion for all my movable and immovable properties and
 business ab. owing to ill health and pressure, I am
 executing this instrument of my first and last will I have
 only one son Shri Ram Aditya Kumar Seta and two daugh-
 ters (i) Srimati Anina Seta wife of Shri Brojo Seta Seta.

of Jagannath Sun Das, Calcutta - 6 and (2) the younger daughter Shrimati Anila Saha and (my) wife Shrimati Sarbani Saha. So that there may not be any kind of dispute among them in future, I am executing this deed and last instrument of will.

The terms are that -

1. Upon my death my son Shri Man Abhaya Kumar Saha shall get in absolute right - the half share of the movable and immovable properties, monies lying in Bank & ornaments and cash money which is left.
2. I bequeath to my wife Shrimati Sarbani Saha - the life interest of enjoying and possessing the remaining half share upon my death - (she) shall not be entitled to alienate or waste any property. If (she) does so, it would be void and in a voidable manner upon the death of my wife the half share held by her shall vest in Shri Man Abhaya Kumar Saha in absolute right; that is to say Shri Man Abhaya

Shri Bimal
Chandra Saha.

Kumar Saha shall be the owners of my properties. For the extent of sixteen annas.

3. My son Shri Man Abhaya Kumar Saha shall remain bound to pay at the rate of 100/- one hundred rupees per month to my eldest daughter Shrimati Anura Saha, wife of Shri Brajchandra Saha, for the education of her children etc. She shall not get nor shall (he) pay the said monthly sum of 100/- one hundred rupees any further after the children of the said daughter are married.

Willen't my life time I have given her in marriage of suitable bride groom. By this time I don't give her any thing.

4. My youngest daughter Shrimati Anula Saha is now studying. I hope to give her marriage willen't my life time.

Should

Should God forbid, her marriage be not performed in child's death. My son Shri man Abhaya Kumar Sastri shall be bound to incur all the expenses for the marriage of the youngest daughter and after her marriage when she will give birth to a child (or children) Shri man Abhaya Kumar Sastri shall and remain bound to give her 100- one hundred rupees per month for (her) education. If after my death the youngest daughter do not marry or if her marriage does not take place, then she shall live as a member of the family and my son Shri man Abhaya Kumar Sastri shall and remain bound to pay her 100- one hundred rupees per month. Besides this the youngest daughter shall not get any share whether in the movable and immovable properties.

5. I appoint my son Shri man Abhaya Kumar Sastri as executor of this will and empower him to take out probate (He) shall take out probate without security and the mother and the son shall enjoy and possess (my properties) remaining joint in accordance with the Hindu law.

To this will, in the presence of the witnesses of my own accord, in good faith, in a sound state of health being led by my own words, free and without being persuaded by any body, I execute this final and last instrument of will by signing my own name here at 1944 Karick of the year 1372 B.S. corresponding to 5th November of the year 1965 A.D.
