NOTE - 1: CORPORATE INFORMATION

Amrita Promoters Private Limited ("The Company") is an unlisted private limited company, incorporated under the provisions of the Companies Act' 1956, in the year 1995, with a Corporate Identity Number of U70101WB1995PTC073526. The company is engaged in Real-Estate business.

NOTE - 2:

Basis of preparation of Financial Statements.

The Financial Statements have been prepared and presented under the historical cost convention on accrual basis of accounting and in accordance with the Generally Accepted Accounting Principles (GAAP) in India. GAAP includes Accounting Standards, specified under Section 133 of the Companies Act'2013, read with Rule 7 of the Companies (Accounts) Rules, 2014. The company has presented financial statements as per formats prescribed by Schedule III of the Companies Act '2013. Except where otherwise stated, the accounting policies are consistently applied.

a. Use of Estimates.

b. Fixed Assets, Depreciation and amortizations.

Tangible Fixed Assets and Intangible Assets:

- (i) Tangible fixed assets are stated at cost of acquisition or construction less accumulated depreciation/ amortization and impairment losses, if any. Cost comprises the purchase price and any attributable cost of bringing the asset to its working condition for its intended use.

- (b) All other investments are classified as "Long Term Investments" and they are carried at cost, however provision for diminution is made to recognize a decline, other than temporary in nature.
- (c) On disposal of an investment, the difference between its weighted average carrying amount and the net disposal proceeds is cgarged or credited to the Statement of Profit and Loss.
- (d) Current Investments readily convertible in known amount of cash and subject to insignificant risk of changes in value are classified as cash and cash equivalents for preparation of Cash Flow Statements.
