



1. This permit is issued for the purpose of the construction of a building or structure on the site of a vacant lot or a lot which has been previously used for a building or structure, and may be renewed for a like period of two years or for period as may be granted. A permit is granted on the basis of statements, information supplied by the applicant, in case of a discrepancy between the same or other information furnished by the applicant and the information furnished by other parties, the Board of Health may, in its discretion, require the applicant to furnish such information as may be necessary to enable the Board of Health to make a proper determination of the facts in connection with the application for a permit.

2. Before commencing construction the applicant must submit to the Board of Health a plan showing the location of the building or structure to be constructed, and a true and correct copy of such plan as received from the applicant, and a true and correct copy of such plan as received from the Board of Health.

3. The owner of a building or structure shall be responsible for the maintenance of the same in accordance with the provisions of the Health Ordinance, Chapter 107, of the Revised Code of the City of St. Louis, Missouri, and for the payment of the license fee thereon.

4. No building or structure shall be erected or altered, or any part thereof, until the applicant has obtained from the Board of Health a permit for the same, and until the same is in accordance with the provisions of the Health Ordinance, Chapter 107, of the Revised Code of the City of St. Louis, Missouri.

5. The owner of a building or structure shall be responsible for the maintenance of the same in accordance with the provisions of the Health Ordinance, Chapter 107, of the Revised Code of the City of St. Louis, Missouri, and for the payment of the license fee thereon.

6. The Board of Health may, in its discretion, require the applicant to furnish such information as may be necessary to enable the Board of Health to make a proper determination of the facts in connection with the application for a permit.
