

1. This Discharge Permit is valid for 1 (One) Year from the date of issuance.
2. This Discharge Permit is issued for the purpose of allowing the discharge of effluent from the treatment plant to the receiving water body.
3. The Discharge Permit does not constitute an endorsement or approval of the quality of the effluent or the receiving water body.
4. If the quality of the effluent or the receiving water body is found to be deficient, the permittee shall be required to take corrective action to bring the effluent or the receiving water body up to the required quality.
5. The Discharge Permit is subject to the terms and conditions of the applicable laws, regulations, and orders of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources.
6. This Discharge Permit is issued in accordance with the provisions of the Clean Water Act and the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination Act.
